

## **SPORTS PAVILION GROUND RULES**

All basketball hoops, air ducts, lights, banners, scoreboards, beams and horizontal cables meet the minimum 15-foot height from the floor, so ruling will be part of ceiling (rule 8.4.2c)

**Beams are part of the back wall and are considered OUT on courts 11 and 12. See photo**  
**ALL net support systems are OUT including the cables and straps that run non horizontal (angle). See photo**  
**ALL raised backboards are considered part of the ceiling. See photo**

Players are not allowed to enter adjacent courts during anytime while playing the ball or after playing the ball, but can play the ball while behind end line of adjacent courts (rule 9b)



The screens if moved while playing the ball, must be by the player playing the ball, not a teammate (rule 9a).


**No cameras are allowed along the screen or behind the courts**




Banners and clock are part of the ceiling
